Our vision has become a reality. In 2017, Chrysalis House staff and the Board of Directors began to contemplate ways to provide treatment services to more women struggling with substance use and mental health disorders. Fast forward to December 1, 2022 and the dedication of the Chrysalis House Campus Expansion in Crownsville. The facilities look like a "Total Home Makeover" consisting of nineteen new beds, tripling the size of the Child Development Center, a modernized and expanded kitchen and dining area, a three-story clinical wing, and renovated administrative offices.

The project team was led by general contractor Hamel Builders Inc., project architect- Studio 343, civil engineers -Drum Loyka & Associates, LLC, and Episcopal Housing Corporation.




Home Sweet Home!

Wow, how appropriate, because here at Chrysalis House we are doing just that at our Crownsville campus as well as at Chrysalis House Healthy Start in Baltimore City. We have been spring cleaning, getting organized, and looking forward to our new and bright future with exciting programs and events for the women and children. The renovation and expansion of CHI is now complete. A huge, heartfelt thank you to our donors, community partners, and the Board of Directors for your important support. I also want to thank the Chrysalis House staff and

especially the clients, for their patience with the transitioning that has taken place over the past several months.

I am looking forward to our Open House on May 24th, where we will showcase the new building, and will share the exciting new plans for our recovery program. We will be adding therapeutic and holistic therapies to our already robust curriculum. I'm excited that we are partnering with several community organizations that will help equip and train the women in running and walking. We have received grant funding from Behavioral Health Client Services and are establishing a Client Fitness Program and will be ordering exercise equipment for an indoor dedicated space for working out. On Earth Day, we planted 200 trees in the meadow, a partnership project with Arundel Rivers Federation. We have been awarded a \$75K bond bill from the state to create a Therapeutic Nature & Walking Trail around the meadow, for clients and staff to use.

It's only been a few months; however, it's been an absolute honor to join the Chrysalis House team and I can't express how excited I am for our future. Again, thank you to all our supporters and I look forward to seeing you at the May Open House!




Chrysalis House Inc. Annual Report

From July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, Chrysalis House Crownsville was a home to 138 women. We served 78 clients in the Intensive Outpatient Program and 22 families in Supportive Housing. Chrysalis House Healthy Start (CHHS) cared for 44 women and their children during this period.
