We are excited to report that we have begun construction on our Campus Expansion Project! After two-plus years of planning and raising resources, we are now on our way to making this important project a reality.

Working with Hamel Builders and its subcontractors, excavation has started for the Treatment Wing, generously underwritten by the Harry & Jeanette Weinberg Foundation. Work has also begun in several interior areas of the building, as well as on an upgraded wastewater treatment system.

Rest. A loving baby blue.


This loving baby blue gives me the Peace that comes from the loving arms of God, most High!


Chrysalis House Inc. Annual Report

From July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, Chrysalis House Crownsville was home to 149 women and 59 children. We served 88 clients in the Intensive Outpatient Program, and 23 families in our Supportive Housing program. Chrysalis House Healthy Start cared for 37 women and their children during this period.
